- **Payment:** Camp fees are listed under each camp. Full payment is due at the time of registration. No refunds will be given for cancellations by participants once registered. We are accepting registrations up to the Friday that is ten days prior to the camp's start date.
- **Cancellations:** Wilson Arts reserves the right to cancel camps due to low enrollment. Campers will be notified by the Tuesday preceding the camp's start on Monday if the camp will be canceled. A full refund will be issued by check to the address on the form or credit towards a different 2024 camp if summer camps are canceled by Wilson Arts.
- Scholarships: Scholarships are available based on need. Call Wilson Arts at (252) 291-4329 for more information. Please submit scholarship applications to Wilson Arts at least two weeks prior to the start of the camp. Applications can be downloaded from https://www.wilsonarts. com/camps or picked up at the Wilson Arts Center.
- Arrivals and Departures: All visual arts campers are to check in at Wilson Arts at 204 Nash St S. All performing

arts campers are to check in at the Boykin Center at 108 Nash Street NE. Camps will be open for check-in at 8:45 a.m. and will begin promptly at 9:00 a.m., and you must accompany your child into the building. Please notify Wilson Arts staff if your child will be late or not attending a day of camp (especially performing arts camps). When picking up your child, you will be required to sign him/ her out. Only persons authorized on the Permission Form will be allowed to pick up your child. If you are more than 30 minutes late picking up your camper, a \$10.00 fee will be assessed.

• **Snacks and Lunches:** Please remember to send snacks and lunch along with drinks to those attending full-day performing arts camps. If your child is attending both morning and afternoon visual arts camps, you may sign them up for the "Lunch Bunch" option, which provides childcare for the hour between camps for \$25 per week. Please note that lunch is NOT included for Lunch Bunch. Please avoid nut products in snacks and lunches for the safety of all of our campers and staff.
